Tuition - \$660 per credit hour

Base Fees - \$765 per semester

Room & Board - \$4250 per semester for double room

Sample Semester:

5 courses x 3 credit hrs each = 15 credit hrs

15 hrs x \$660 tuition = \$9,900

Base fees = \$765

*Estimated book cost = \$300

*Total semester cost = \$10,665 (\$10,965 w/ books)

*Total semester cost w/ Room & Board = \$14,915 (\$15,215 w/ books)

*Student must have aid that exceeds the total semester cost in order for a book voucher to be set up for purchasing books.

How much Federal Student Aid can you expect to receive?

<u>Pell Grant</u> – Not everyone qualifies for Pell Grant. It is an income based grant aid determined by your FAFSA. Only the Financial Aid Office can tell you how much you will qualify for.

If you qualify for Pell Grant and you are enrolled in at least 12 hours per semester, you could receive:

From \$370 - \$3697.50 per semester

<u>Federal Student Loans</u> – Federal Student Loans are available for students if they choose to accept them. The amount is determined by your FAFSA, grade level, dependency status as determined by your FAFSA, and the total of all other grants or scholarships you'll be receiving.
